

# E Safety Survey 2011

Many thanks to all of the schools, libraries and other children's settings that participated in the Camden safeguarding children board's (CSCB) e safety survey in November 2010.

The survey was designed to establish the extent of Camden's children's;

- Use of the internet
- Awareness of the risks associated with use of the internet
- Understanding of how to stay safe online

As we all know, Camden children are a well informed and street wise bunch and generally they demonstrated in the survey that they were aware of the risks and of how to keep themselves safe. However, they also taught us additional risks that we had not been aware of;

“Don't spill orange juice on your computer or download a virus or your parents will 'kill' you”!

And we picked up new tips for helping children stay safe;

“Parents should never take away our PC's or phones if something bad happens to us online, because we just won't tell them about it next time.”

The survey results (attached) gave us a useful insight into children's levels of understanding of the issues and enabled us to develop a plan to increase further, children's understanding of the risks of going on line, as well as give them tips on how to enjoy the internet safely.

The plan which has been put into place involved; raising awareness of the risks and how to stay safe; delivering a programme of e safety training to parents, staff and children; producing e safety posters for children and staff and a leaflet for parents and setting up a system to ensure that any concerning e safety incidents that have placed a child at risk of harm are reported to social services.

We would now like to run the survey again to establish whether this awareness raising has had an impact on this years Year 4 and up age group and to establish the e safety awareness of Years 1-3.

There are two surveys this year;

## **Year 1- Year 3 survey**

The Year1- Year 3 survey is designed to be completed in a classroom/group setting, with the teacher/group leader asking questions of the whole group and collating numbers of responses and comments. (see attachment)
